



Bahamas Wahoo Championship

2011-2012 15TH SEASON OF COMPETITION

- Wahoo only with a **20 pound** minimum weight
- Six lines. Two wire lines per boat may be used. No electric reels.
- Boats may leave the docks at **7:00 AM**.
- Lines In at **8:00 AM**. Lines Out at **4:00PM**.
- Boats must pass the terminator line by **5:00 PM**.
- Weigh-In. **5:00 to 6:00 PM**. No mutilated fish. The decision of the weigh-master is final.
- There are no boundaries.
- The Tournament is open to both Inboard and Outboard engine vessels.

This is a **Boat** tournament/Championship. Boats may be substituted from tournament to tournament but not once a tournament starts. Fish cannot be transferred from one boat to another.

SCORING

- ❖ **First Place.** The sum of the heaviest FIVE qualifying fish. (Two per day, less one)
- ❖ **High Point Boat Daily-** The sum of the TWO heaviest Wahoo weighed in each day

AWARDS

- ❖ 1st Overall Winner, 2nd Runner Up
- ❖ High Point Boat Day One, Two and Three.
- ❖ Heaviest Wahoo caught in the Tournament.
- ❖ Captain of the Winning boat. Crew (2) of the winning boat.
